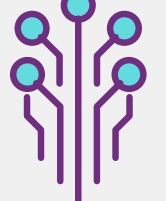

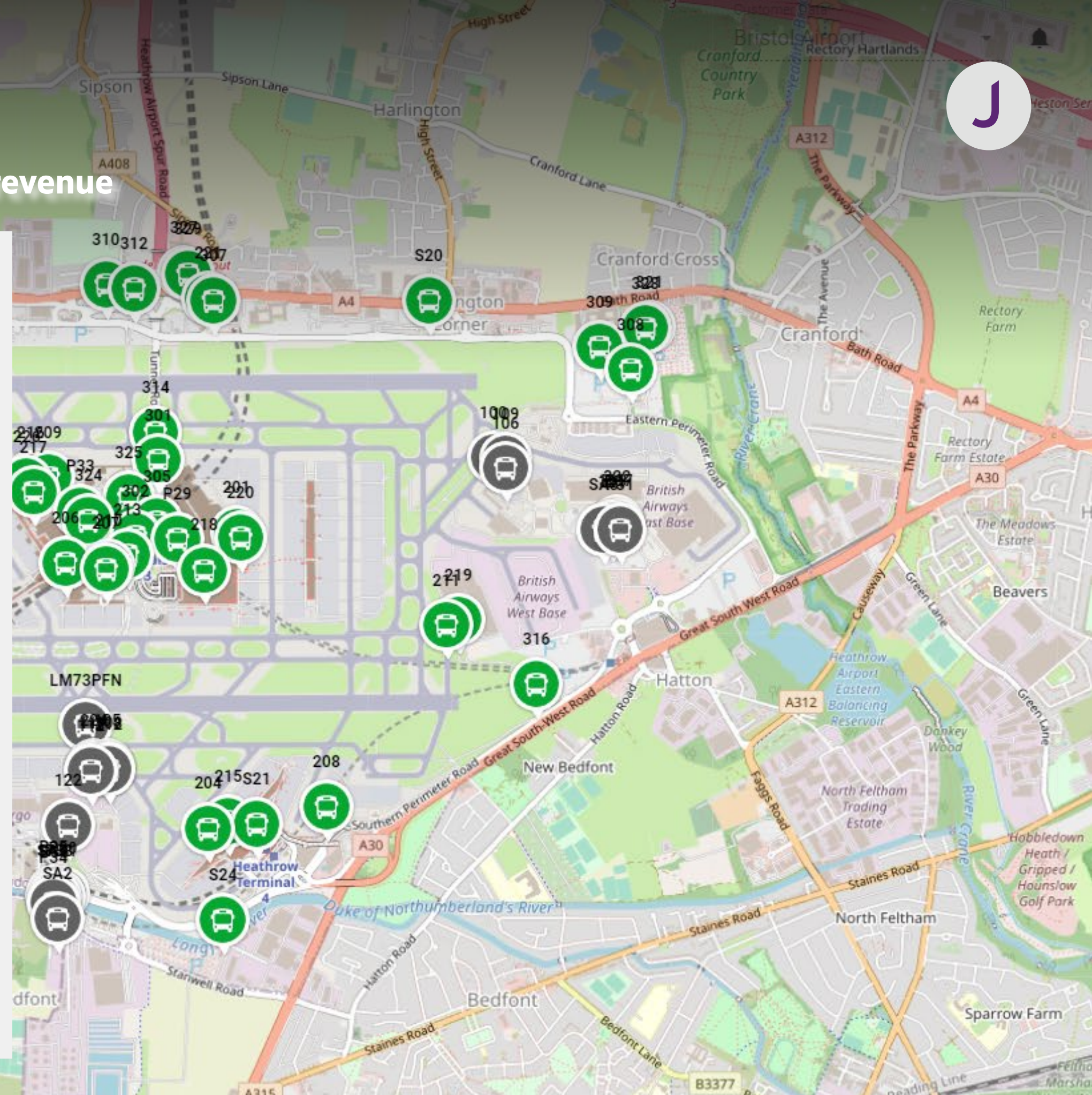

2023 H1 Results

- Revenue increased 146% to £21.8m (2022: £8.9m)
- Gross profit increased 96% to £6.4m (2022: £3.3m)
- Underlying profit before tax increased by 277% to £2.5m (2022: £0.7m)
- Profit before tax £1.7m (2022: £0.17m)
- Cash and cash equivalents £11.3m (2022: £1.2m)
- Diluted Earnings Per Share 8.72p (2022: 1.84p)

2023 H1 Highlights

J

- Completed acquisition of IGL Limited, together with its subsidiaries (“Infotec”) for an aggregate consideration of £8.7m
- Further increase in Journeo portal connections, up to 12,000 from 10,000 at the year end
- £0.4m investment in surface mount production technology, to bolster Group manufacturing capacity
- Further expansion of our Airport solution, following award from First Bus for East Midlands Airport
- Journeo became first UK displays manufacturer to embrace new industry communications standard RTIGT047, following deployment to the City of Edinburgh
- Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) project with a further update to be provided in the 2023 Annual Report
